

Webasto appoints Jörg Bremer as new Chief Financial Officer as of November 1, 2024

Arne Kolfenbach resigns from the Management Board at his own request with effect October 31, 2024

Stockdorf – September 19, 2024 – Webasto, the global system partner to the automotive industry, is about to change the responsible board member for the finance division. After four years as Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of one of the 100 largest suppliers to the automotive sector worldwide, Arne Kolfenbach has decided to leave the company by end of October and to pursue his professional career outside of Webasto. Jörg Bremer, previously CFO of KraussMaffei Group, will succeed him on November 1, 2024.
